Length limit – no longer than 2 pages.

Page format: Document margins – 20 mm; Style – Times New Roman, 12 pt.; Line spacing – Single-spaced; Header – 1,0.

Materials in the abstract should be arranged as follows:

- Author's name (bold);
- Academic title;
- Institution;
- Title of the abstract (capitals, bold);
- Main text;
- References (if necessary).

The works-cited list should be at the end of the abstract arranged in ABC order. A reference to a source cited in the abstract should appear in the body of the text in square brackets indicating the source number on the list followed by a comma and the page (pages) number. E.g., [1, p. 12].
