Volume – up to 10 pages, including References.

- post, place of employment, a scientific degree, academic rank (no abbreviations, full justification, in italics, line spacing 1);
- full name of a research supervisor (semi bold)— for students;
- post, place of employment, a scientific degree, academic rank of a research supervisor (no abbreviations, full justification, in italics, line spacing 1);
 - blank string;
 - title (capitals, semi-bold, center alignment).
