## Requirements for abstracts:

- ✓ Section name (Times New Roman, 12, on the right).
- ✓ Abstracts title is center-aligned (the first word is capitalized, without a dot): Times New Roman, 14, bold.
- ✓ One line below, on the right: full name, scientific degree, academic rank, author's affiliation (in full), information about a research advisor (for those who does not have a scientific degree); Times New Roman, 12.
- ✓ One line below text meeting the following requirements: A4 (210×297), portrait orientation, all margins 2 cm, Times New Roman, 14, line spacing 1,5; text alignment justified; paragraph indention 1.25 cm.
- ✓ A list of references (References) is at the end of the article; please, adhere to the requirements of the National Standard of Ukraine <u>DSTU</u> 8302:2015 "Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General <u>provisions and compilation rules</u>". Within the text, references are put in square brackets, which indicate the position number in the list of references and page: e.g., [7, p. 16].
  - ✓ **Text volume** up to 5 pages including References.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts which do not meet the conference subject and general requirements.

Abstracts are not subject to additional improvement; hence, they should be thoroughly revised by an author, who is responsible for the materials.
