Procedure for submitting materials

Only vice-rectors for research from Ukrainian higher education institutions can join the conference.

Participation is **free**. Conference participants will be provided with 3-days accommodation and 4-days meal. The organizers do not cover travel expenses.

Conference participants will be provided with accommodation and meals. All interested in taking part in the conference should take the following steps:

1. **until October 2, 2024 (inclusively) fill in a participation form**;
2. **until November 15, 2024 (inclusively) send the abstracts** to the Organizing Committee: conf.uzhnu@cuesc.org.ua.

Conditions of Participation

All conference participants will be provided with an electronic collection of conference proceedings and a certificate of participation. A collection of conference proceedings will be published by the European publishing house “Izdevniecība



“**Baltija Publishing**” (Riga, Latvia) Each abstract included in the collection is

assigned **DOI** that makes it available on the web-site Open Ukrainian Citation Index (OUCI), which was designed by specialists of the State Scientific and Technical Library of Ukraine by the order of the Council of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine.

The collection of conference proceedings will be available on open platform of the European publisher “Izdevniecība “Baltija Publishing” at the link.

An electronic collection of conference proceedings will be sent out **after December 25, 2024**.

Requirements for abstracts

English paper title is centered (bold capital letters, Times New Roman, no. 16)

In one spacing, Ukrainian paper title is centered (bold capital letters, Times New Roman, no. 16)

In one spacing, in the center, there is a full name in Latin characters, academic degree, academic rank (if any), post, department, affiliation, city, and country (in English); Times New Roman no. 14.

In one spacing, in the center, there is a full name in Latin characters, academic degree, academic rank (if any), post, department, affiliation, city, and country (in Ukrainian); Times New Roman no. 14.

After one spacing there is a text which should meet the following requirements: A-4, all fields – 2 cm, Times New Roman № 14, line spacing – 1,5.

References (without repetitions) are at the bottom of the text taking into account the National Standard of Ukraine DSTU 8302: 2015 “Information and documentation. Bibliographic reference. General principles and rules of composition”. Citations in the text should be marked with numerical order of a source according to the list and page (pages) number, for example [7, p. 16].

Text volume is **up to 5 pages**, including References.

Languages: Ukrainian, English, Slovenian, Romanian.

Please note that the **maximum number of co-authors** is 3.

Academic integrity

The Organizing Committee guarantees high-quality anonymous peer-review of every research paper. All conference abstracts are subject to checking for plagiarism using [StrikePlagiarism.com](https://www.strikeplagiarism.com) by the Polish company [Plagiat.pl](https://www.plagiat.pl).

Prohibition on using the aggressor state's scholarly papers

Languages: Ukrainian, English, Slovenian, Romanian. It is prohibited citing and including in the reference list Russian-language publications published in any country, including papers written in other languages but published in Russia and Belarus.
