Scientists, post-graduate students and young scientists of law faculties of higher education and/or scientific institutions are invited to participate in the conference.

Practitioners (judges, lawyers, prosecutors, notaries, public finance auditors and others) from Ukraine and other countries of the world can also take part.

Conference languages: Ukrainian, English.

Scholars from any country where Ukrainian and / or English are not official *can* add an abstract of the report (scientific article) in their native language (volume - 5-7 sentences). This will help to correctly understand the meanings that the scientist put into the words (passed through them)



The work of the following **sections** is planned within the conference:

- 1. History and theory of state and law, philosophy of law;
- 2. Constitutional law, public international law;
- 3. Civil law and process, family law, housing law, private international law;
- 4. Commercial law and process;
- 5. Labor law, social security law;
- 6. Environmental, land, agricultural law;
- 7. Administrative law and process, financial (tax&budget), information law;
- 8. Criminal law, criminal executive law, criminal procedure, criminology, criminalistics.

1) Title of the report in the middle of the line (first word begins with a capital letter; without a dot): font Times New Roman № 14, bold. EXAMPLE:

Problematic issues of jurisdiction in criminal cases

2) Below, in one space, in the middle - last name, first name, patronymic of the author; supervisor (if any), full name of the institution where the author works / studies: italics, font Times New Roman № 14. EXAMPLE:

Kostenko Roman Viktorovych, Ph.D., Associate Professor Zaporizhia National University

- 3) In one space the text of report, which must meet the following requirements: A-4 format, margins: top, bottom, left, right 2 cm, font Times New Roman N_0 14, line spacing 1.0.
- 4) The list of used sources (without repetitions) is made out at the end of the text under the name "Literature". In the text, footnotes are indicated by square brackets indicating the ordinal number of the source in the list and through a comma page (pages) numbers. F.i.: [4, p. 89].

Text size: up to 5-6 pages with a list of used sources.
